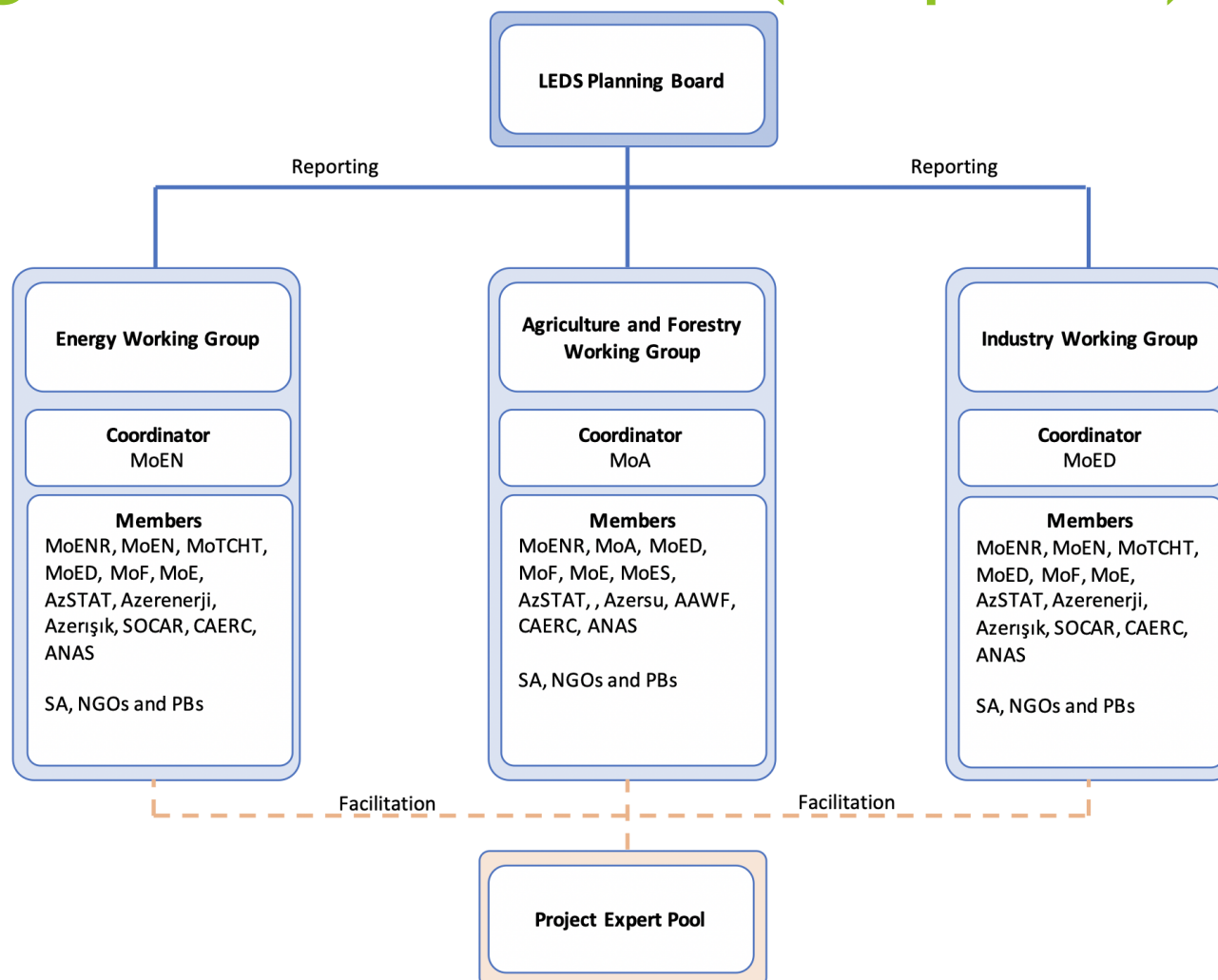
Preparation/Coordination Meeting
