# Moldova's f-gases related commitments

## International

- Convention for the Protection of the Ozone Layer
- Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer

## Regional

- Association Agreement between Republic of Moldova and European Union
- Regulation (EU) 517/2014 regarding fluorinated greenhouse gases

# Moldova's situation on f-gases

- On October 15, 2016, in Kigali, Rwanda, Decision XXVIII/1: Additional Amendment to the Montreal Protocol, aimed at phasing out the use of hydrofluorocarbons worldwide, was signed by Moldova.
- In the period 1995-2019 f-gases emissions increased from 3.27 kt CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent in 1995 to 247.02 kt CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent in 2019
- This is an increasing of emissions by about 75.6 times.

# Draft law on f-gases

- Draft law was developed with the support of the EU4Climate project.
- Draft law transposes into national legislation Regulation (EU) 517/2014 regarding fluorinated greenhouse gases
- Scope of the law is to create the legal framework for the reduction of fluorinated greenhouse gas emissions in order to mitigate climate change and protect the environment as a whole.
- The law is an instrument of implementing the HFC phase out commitments assumed by Moldova under the Montreal Protocol

Years	Percentage for calculating the maximum amount of hydrofluorocarbons to be placed on the market and the corresponding quotas
2024-2028	freezing consumption at 100% of base level consumption <sup>(1)</sup>
2029-2034 (stage I)	90% from the base level consumption
2035-2039 (stage II)	70% from the base level consumption
2040-2044 (stage III)	50% from the base level consumption
2045 and further (stage IV)	20% from the base level consumption
